



LEED and Floor Product Categories

If you're working towards obtaining the maximum number of LEED points on your building project, it's important to understand the sections, credits and products that are impacted by flooring product choices. This table identifies which LEED sections and credits are impacted by flooring product choices, plus the Armstrong™ products that can contribute to qualifying for points in those sections.

LEED NC: Applies to the entire building — new construction and major renovations.

LEED CI: Applies to tenant improvements in new or existing office and institutional spaces.
